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### WINTERSHALL DEA SUPPORTS STUDENTS WITH A REFUGEE OR MIGRATION BACKGROUND

- Wintershall Dea and Studierendenwerk Hamburg start cooperation
- Company becomes co-sponsor of the "Hamburg Scholarship"
- Support for students initially for three years


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Hamburg / Kassel. To help students in particularly difficult life situations, Wintershall Dea will sponsor the "Hamburg Scholarship" project of the Studierendenwerk (student support) Hamburg with a total of 30,000 euros over the next three years.

With this scholarship, the Studierendenwerk Hamburg has been providing financial and non-material support since the winter term of 2018/19. It is awarded to students with a refugee or migration background who are successfully completing their studies despite special life situations. The scholarship holders receive a monthly allowance of 150 euros as well as access to the scholarship holders' network, which they can use to establish important contacts with institutions and companies in Hamburg. In the funding year of 2022/23, a total of 26 students will be supported by the Hamburg Scholarship. In the following funding year of 2023/24, the Studierendenwerk intends to award the scholarship to 25 and 30 students - the application process has not yet begun.



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
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As a co-sponsor of the Hamburg Scholarship, Wintershall Dea wants to support young talents. In addition to financial support, the company also offers scholarship holders the opportunity to complete internships, to work as student trainees or to realise projects for final theses while being mentored by Wintershall Dea employees.

At the same time, Wintershall Dea intends to continue its long-standing commitment to a diverse, democratic society that offers participation on an equal footing to all people, regardless of their origin, age, gender or financial means. "We are convinced that diversity, openness and education are the basis for respectful coexistence and a strong society," says Michael Sasse, Head of Communications at Wintershall Dea. "That is why it is important to us to support young people in furthering their education, getting involved and thus advancing us as a society - especially with the experience and different perspectives they bring with them from their countries of origin. The Hamburg Scholarship is an important project for this goal and we are proud to sponsor it with other strong companies." Other partners of the Hamburg Scholarship are currently Gasnetz Hamburg GmbH, Hapag Lloyd AG, Helm AG, Hamburger Sparkasse AG and the companies Marquard & Bahls and Mabanaft.

"For 100 years we have been committed to making studying a success," explains Jürgen Allemeyer, Managing Director of the Studierendenwerk Hamburg. "We see diversity as an enrichment. I am very pleased that
