means young researchers, but also external speakers from Germany and across the globe can take part in the STEM Student Congress.

In a video message to mark the opening of the STEM Student Congress, Thilo Wieland, member of the Wintershall Dea Executive Board, said: "The current Covid-19 pandemic has shown us that we need cross-border, international research if we want to tackle major challenges together. In this regard, the congress is a lighthouse project that shines out far beyond Kassel."
