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DEA gives up "Völkersen H1" water disposal well

DEA Deutsche Erdoel AG is finally giving up its licence rights for the decommissioned "Völkersen H1" reservoir water disposal well. The well is located to the north east of the municipality of Scharnhorst and has already been out of service since July 2012. The decommissioning of the plant for returning reservoir water deep into the ground was carried out at the time in order to take due account of the local concerns regarding risks to the drinking water in the Panzenberg water protection area.

During the many years when the "Völkersen H1" reservoir water disposal well was in operation, there were no adverse effects on the drinking water quality whatsoever. By finally giving up its licence rights on "Völkersen H1", DEA is once again underlining its readiness to maintain good neighbourly relations and to accommodate the residents and their local municipal representatives with this business decision.

Top priority at DEA is attached to the safe and environmentally-friendly exploration and production of natural gas. In the district of Verden/Aller, too, the company is planning further drilling projects that will be presented to the public after planning has reached completion.
