# DEA Deutsche Erdoel AG makes donation to earthquake victims in Mexico

The German E&P company DEA Deutsche Erdoel AG donates 25,000 Euros to support the relief efforts in the affected areas of Mexico. The consequences of the heavy earthquakes that struck the country in September are extremely severe. Many people have lost their lives or their livelihoods.
